ESSENTIAL VISITS

DISCOVERY

• Duration : 1h30

Explore 25 centuries of history in our standing collections.

This visit takes you along the tracks of Antiquity in Nîmes, revealing the influences of 'Romanness' during the various periods of history and time...

EXPRESS VISIT

• Duration : 1h

Perhaps you only have a little bit of time but you would like to see the whole of the museographic route? This visit is perfect for you!

TEMPORARY EXHIBITION

• Duration : 1h

« The Roman Emperor, a mortal among the gods », from May 13 to September 19, 2021.

A visit that reveals and explains the bases of the imperial cult initiated by the emperor Augustus, giving him a strange status of mortal among the gods.

FULL VISIT

• Duration : 2h

A visit to find out everything about the museum—combining exploration of the standing collections and the temporary exhibition.

LUNCH VISIT

In addition to an independent or guided visit among those available, enjoy a meal at 'La Table du 2'.

On the 2nd floor of the Musée de la Romanité and with a splendid view of the Roman arena, this brasserie run by starred chefs focuses on regional produce in a friendly, clean-cut setting.

Two starred chefs combine to design a menu for each season. Franck Putelat, with 2 Michelin stars, signs the menu and manages the team in the kitchen. But as gastronomy is something to share, an international chef joins Frank each year to propose a dish for each season.

IN VINO VERITAS

• Duration : 1h30/ 2h

What are the origins of wine, a beverage thousands of years old and so popular today? How was it drunk? What rites are related to its use? This is a theme visit to explore the history of Bacchus and the ancient secrets of wine, followed by a tasting of Roman wines made using recipes drawn from experimental archaeology.

THEME VISITS

OUR ANCESTORS THE GAULS' : BETWEEN MYTH AND REALITY

• Duration : 1h30

We are fascinated by the Gauls. But the image that we have of them is often riddled with untruths... We reveal the life of the Gauls who lived in the region through a fascinating visit that takes you close to these warlike peoples who were influenced over time by Mediterranean populations and traditions.

ROMAN RELIGIONS

• Duration : 1h30

Roman religions are difficult to understand as they were fundamentally different to those today. Polytheist and based on the respect of rituals, they might seem rigid and uniform at first sight. But they were also community-centred and hence had as many variations as there were social groups, and they changed with developments of the Roman world. Roman, indigenous and oriental religions—from the Imperial cult to domestic cults—let us examine the Roman religions of the Nîmes region through the museum's collections.

GRAECO-ROMAN MYTHS

• Duration : 1h30

As a symbol or a mirror, mythology recounts our history through the adventures and passions of gods and heroes. Through focus on the works shown in the museum, (re-) discover the fascinating stories of certain great mythological figures: Bacchus and the praise of drunkenness, Hercules and his 12 labours, Athena and her owl, Achilles and Ajax, heroes of the Trojan War, etc.

ROMANS AT HOME : PRIVATE DECORATION

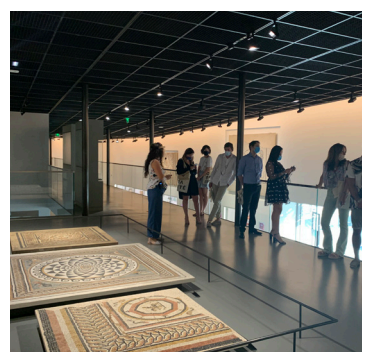
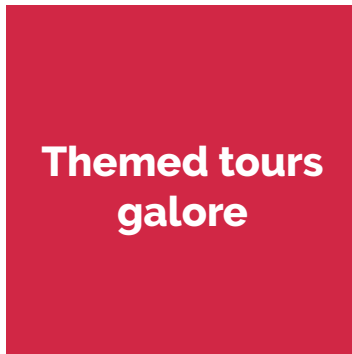
• Duration : 1h30

The Romans awarded great importance to all the details of the decoration of their homes. Mosaics, frescoes, sculptures, and sophisticated, coloured décors reveal a certain aesthetic level that made it possible to show the social rank of the owner. In many rooms of the museum you can see all Roman trends in decoration in Nîmes some 2000 years ago.

CHRISTIAN BELIEFS IN THE MIDDLE AGES

• Duration : 1h30

In the middle Ages, the Church set the rhythm of daily life and modelled the behaviour of believers—who attempted to live as good Christians. Life after death was at the heart of heart of their concerns. Which pathways would take them to Heaven? And which should be avoided so as not to go to Hell? From the original sin of Adam and Eve to the Last Judgement, biblical scenes and the notions of Good and Evil were carved in stone and guided Christians from birth to death.
